Rules and Regulations:

We encourage the originality, understanding, depth of content and comprehensiveness of the paper. The guidelines for paper presentation are as follows:

1. All the participants are required to bring two hard copies of their paper along with them on the day of the event.
2. The presentations/papers will be collected from the participants at the time of registration. Presentations should only be in ppt, pptx or pdf format.

3. Team size is restricted to maximum of two members.
4. The manuscript must be written in times new roman with font size 12. The spacing between lines should be one and page limit should be 12. Only text directly related to the item being presented and any accompanying illustrations, tables, figures, etc., will count toward the 12-page limit. Title page, tables of contents, and bibliographies shall not be counted towards the limit.
5. All papers should have a bibliography/works-cited page and appropriate. Papers omitting a bibliography or using plagiarized material will be automatically disqualified.
6. Photographs should be treated as being equivalent to figures, with the caption being placed at the bottom of the photograph. Photocopies of photographs are not acceptable.
7. **Participation fee is Rs100/- per team.**
8. Short listed Students are requested to report the venue 30 minutes before the start of event.
